TENDER NOTICE

**Loading and Transportation of Ilmenite from IRE's Orissa Plant
at Chartrapur to TTP's site at Thiruvananthapuram**

Sealed Quotations are invited from experienced contractors for the work of loading, transporting of approx. 12000 MTs of Ilmenite per annum made available from Indian Rare Earths Limited (IRE), Chatrapur, Orissa to TTP's site at Kochvueli, Thiruvananthapuram 21. for a period of ONE year from the date of award of the work.

Contractors should quote their rate per MT for ilmenite from IRE Orissa inclusive of charges for loading at the site of procurement, transport to TTP's site. Unloading work will be done by TTP's employees.

The transportation contractor should have sufficient infrastructure to carry the material by trucks from IRE, Orissa to TRAVANCORE TITANIUM PRODUCTS LTD. Thiruvananthapuram in bulk quantities.

CONDITIONS

1. The successful tenderer shall execute a Performance Agreement on a Rs.100 stamp paper as per the specimen provided by TTP
2. The contractor shall have to deliver a minimum of 1000 Mts of Ilmenite per month. Work under this contract is to be started immediately on acceptance of the tender and Ilmenite made available from IRE Orissa should be delivered to TTP godown at Thiruvananthapuram within 15 days from the date of acceptance of the workorder. Failure to deliver the material within this stipulated period will result in the cancellation of contract and forfeiture of Security Deposit without any notice, and the company will have the right to have the work executed by any other person of the company's choice in whatever manner deems fit and to recover the loss if any sustained by the company in that connection from the contractor.
3. The normal tenure of the contract is ONE year. The company reserves the right to extend the tenure of the contract for a further period of 3 or more months from the date of expiry of the contract and the contractor is bound to carry out the work at the same rate, terms and conditions.

4. The contractor shall present the materials at the TTP weigh bridge for weighment and unload it into TTP godown after weighment.
5. Only dry ilmenite will be permitted to be weighed at TTP weigh bridge and received into TTP godown. In any consignment of ilmenite be found wet, it will not be allowed to enter the factory premises.
6. All consignments of Ilmenite will be weighed on TTP's weigh bridge before transfer into our godown. On the net weight recorded on TTP weigh bridge (less weight of bag, if the cargo is bagged) will be accepted as final. A transit loss of 1% (one percent) will be allowed. The difference in cost, in excess of transit loss allowed, observed between the quantity delivered by IRE and that received at our site as recorded in our Weigh Bridge will be recovered from the contractor.
7. The work shall include loading of Ilmenite made available from IRE Orissa, transportation to TTP site where our employees will unload the material. All incidental expenses at IRE sites enroute and at TTP factory site should be borne by the contractor. If the cargo is transported in bags, all expenses connected with bagging, cost of bag etc. should be borne by the contractor. Company will not supply bags or any of the other materials or equipments required for this work. The rate quoted should be valid for a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of quotation.
8. Persons employed by the contractor for this work will be responsible to the Contractor alone and any loss or damage arising from any act on the part of such persons will be recovered from the contractor alone. The Contractor shall be responsible for discharging the statutory obligation including wages contribution etc. that may be required to be paid in respect of workers/employees engaged by the contractor for the execution of the works awarded to him by the Company under any labour enactment such as Factories Act, Minimum Wages Act, Personal Injuries Act, Employees Provident Fund Act, ESI Act, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act etc., of any settlements or any statutory modification / notification thereof. In case the Company is called upon to make any such payments or to do any act/deed on account of the failure of the Contractor to do so in time the contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the company against any such loss or damage that may be occasioned to the Company in this behalf. Security Deposit will be released only on receipt of any indemnity bond to this effect. In case the company is satisfied that the presence of any of the employee of the Contractor within the factory premises is likely to be prejudicial to the Company's business or is undesirable in the interest of the Company, the Company will be at liberty to disallow any such person from entering all or any specified area within the factory

9. Lorries will normally be permitted to enter TTP premises only between 06.00 am and 08.00 pm. However, the company reserves the right to bring in any change in the timings
10. It is not binding on the company to accept the lowest offer. The Company reserves the right to cancel the contract or extend the validity of the contract without assigning any reason whatsoever.
11. The successful tenderer shall be bound to execute all works as required under the terms of the contract and shall not be entitled to claim whatsoever against the company for compensation or otherwise during the terms of the contract.
12. A proportionate increase/decrease in rate will be allowed consequent on the increase/decrease in diesel price as per our existing formula based on “to and fro” distance covered from the procurement of the materials from IRE, Orissa. No other increase will be allowed.
13. The rate of increase/decrease on account of diesel price increase/decrease will be considered only if the increase/decrease is Re.1 or more at a time.
14. The company reserves the right to increase/decrease the quantity of Ilmenite made available from IRE, Orissa to be lifted and delivered by the contractor any time during the contract as per requirements of the company or according to the quantity made available from IRE Orissa, The contractor will have no right to claim any compensation or damages whatsoever on account of such variations.
15. The tenderer shall not incorporate any condition in the offer as conditioned offers are liable to be rejected.
16. Normally payment of transportation charge will be made for lots of 300 MTs delivered.
17. Tender offer should be submitted in the Tender form issued by the Company or can be downloaded from our website www.travancoretitanium.com . In the case of downloaded forms, tenders should be accompanied with DD for Rs.2,253 being cost of tender documents.
18. Quotations in the attached proforma should be accompanied by a Demand Draft for Rs.50,000 drawn in favour of Travancore Titanium Products Ltd., payable at Thiruvananthapuram towards EMD . Cheques will not be accepted. No interest will be paid for the EMD.
19. The maximum quantity that can be delivered in a month should be indicated in the tender.
20. Sealed quotations superscribed “ *Quotion for the transport of Ilmenite from IRE, Orissa to TTP , Thiruvananthapuram*” should reach the undersigned before 2.00 p.m. on 14-07-2011 and will be opened on the same day at 2.30 p.m.

21. Security Deposit for the contract is Rs.TWO (2) lakhs and the same is to be remitted to the company by the contractor within a day from the date of acceptance of the Work Order. No interest will be payable for the Security Deposit. Failure to remit the SD in time will result in the rejection of the offer and forfeiture of EMD without any notice.
22. These conditions of tender duly signed in all the sheets should be attached to the quotation in the prescribed form. Offers not accompanied by the required EMD or incomplete in any other respect will be rejected.
23. All disputes/differences arising out of or in connection with the contract shall be referred to the Sole Arbitration of the Chairman of TTP Ltd. Or his nominee under the provisions of Arbitration & conciliation Act, 1996 and the courts at Thiruvananthpauram alone will have the jurisdiction to deal with all matters relating to this contract.
